Attestation:

Guidelines for direct enrollment in Advance Diploma Course (Interior and Fashion Design)

1. Entrance Examination-Candidates will appear in the entrance examination through which their eligibility will be tested on the basis of the one year diploma course that they have already completed. There will be two papers for the said entrance examination. Paper 1 - Mock test (theory paper, full marks 100, pass marks 50). Paper 2 - Time Sketch (practical paper - drawing based full marks 100, pass marks 50). Candidates will be eligible to take direct admission in 2nd year (Advance Diploma) subject to successful clearance in the entrance examination.
2. Direct admission in 2nd year (including entrance examination fees) : Candidates will pay Rs.5000.00 as direct admission fees along with the course fees.
3. Submission of sessional sheet of one year diploma course that candidates have already completed : Candidates will submit their sessional drawing sheets or portfolio of one year diploma course to the concerned authority of respective branch. These drawing sheets will be evaluated by the concerned faculty and marks acquired will be added to the marks of entrance examination.
4. Candidates must satisfy all above mentioned criteria to be eligible to take direct admission in Advance Diploma Course and to continue their studies from 2nd year (Module 5) onwards.

Re-enrollment for autonomous courses:

Candidates who are taking or have enrolled for different Autonomous courses of EXIN, their registration will be valid up to duration of the course for which they have enrolled. Within this duration if candidates are incapable to continue their course due to any personal reason, then at the end of their course duration their enrollment will be invalid. If candidates are interested to resume the course then they must be enrolled as fresh candidate by paying the course fees as per the current fees chart and their registration will be considered as new registration. The amount that the student paid at the time of their previous admission, 50% of the amount can be reduced from the current course fees and the new registration process will be continued accordingly.

Rules related to Module Examination:

On the expiry of each module within a session, the institute will evaluate the progress made by each student. On pre-assigned dates, at both the centres, final examination will be held at the end of every second and fourth module concurrently. The duration of the examination may range between three to six hours, without any break. All students need to pass in every individual paper (for Interior Design Course) Viva-Voce and professional apprenticeship. In case any student fails in any subject and wishes to review the paper, he/she may apply to Asia Pacific Head Office to seek permission to reappear in supplementary examination against payment of the requisite fees. Students who are unable to appear in any examination or viva may also apply for re-examination and or fresh viva to the college authorities subject to payment of requisite fees within a period of 3 months. Any absence in any examination and or viva programme, even under medical grounds, will be treated as a failure in that examinations or viva program. Under such circumstances, the candidate will have to appear in a supplementary examination in the concerned paper(s) and or re-viva programme.

Supplementary Examination Fees/Formalities:

- A supplementary examination / re-viva may be allowed to a candidate against application and supplementary examination fees of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) for individual paper / papers and Rs.5000 for viva.
- In order to re-check sessional sheets the student must submit an application to the controller of examinations along with fee of Rs.5,000 /- (Rupees five thousand only) for all sessional sheets.
- Application for permission to sit in a supplementary examination must be acquired within 15 days from the date of publication of result along with the requisite fees. Candidates for supplementary examinations must appear along with regular examinees, as per the notified examination schedule in the immediate subsequent examination.
- Candidates who are declared as 'FAILURES' in the

examination must appear for supplementary examinations immediately subsequent to the examination in which the candidates have been declared a 'FAILURE'. If a candidate, remains absent for the supplementary examination the candidate will be declared a 'FAILURE' and will not be eligible for any supplementary examination.

In case of 'FAILURE' in any paper, in all the three chances detailed above, the student will have to take readmission to the course along with fresh payment of fees as per the admission chart of the center prevalent at that time.

Review of Answer Scripts:

Any student who is not satisfied with the assessment of one or more answer scripts(s) may apply for review within 15 days from the date of publication of the result. The applicant must pay a fixed amount of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per paper.

Leave & Withdrawals:

A leave of absence must be obtained from the organization and the faculty in whose class the student is enrolled. The authorised person of the institution grants a leave for a specified time against necessary documentation and a written approval. The student is expected to return and resume classes. The student should inform the concerned authority of his/her intent to return. A student may withdraw from the programme at his / her own will. The organisation may penalise any student who fails to attain class at the end of the period of authorized leave. The Management reserves the right to remove a student from the program at any time, without assigning any reason

5. The behavior of the students at all time, within or outside the campus must be above board and must reflect a sense of responsibility.
 7. Students are required to show due regard for the rights and the properties of the institute. Any candidate found guilty of this behavior shall be liable for punishment and might be expelled from the institute.

Disputes & Jurisdiction

All disputes, differences, controversies, claims and questions whatsoever arising out of, or related to during the program period or thereafter between the organization and any candidate or their respective representatives touching upon or related to the rules/terms or any clause contained in this prospectus or in any way relating to or arising from such engagement in the program/training course shall be referred for arbitration to a sole arbitrator as may be appointed by the management of the organization. Such arbitration shall be in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as on the date of reference. The seat of such arbitration shall be in Kolkata in India and Dhaka in Bangladesh. It is expressly understood that any student taking admission under the organization's program agrees to be bound by this instant arbitration clause. The organization may allot any batch suitable to the organization and the student requires waiting any amount of time for a minimum quorum of 15 students to register for the commencement of the batch.

Miscellaneous:

The medium of instruction for all courses in all campuses is in English and local languages. For physical fitness, the competent authority at his/ her discretion may refer any candidate to any appropriate medical authority for ascertaining the physical fitness of the candidate to undergo the requirements of the course. The report of medical authority shall be submitted to the regional head for further necessary action. It is to be noted that physically handicapped candidates are

not provided with any additional facilities. Models, prototypes, slides are used extensively in the design studio. The principle objective is to develop the dormant talent of an individual undertaking the training and to prepare him / her to be successful in the challenging world of interior architecture. Site visits, case study, market survey and research seminars / guest lectures / panel discussions are objectively done to supplement within the modules to enable the site practically. Site visits, case studies, market surveys / research are done with real life situations. Guest lecture / panel discussions are organized by EXIN where eminent architects / specialists share their experience with the students to enlighten and encourage them.

Methods of Instruction-Design Studio:

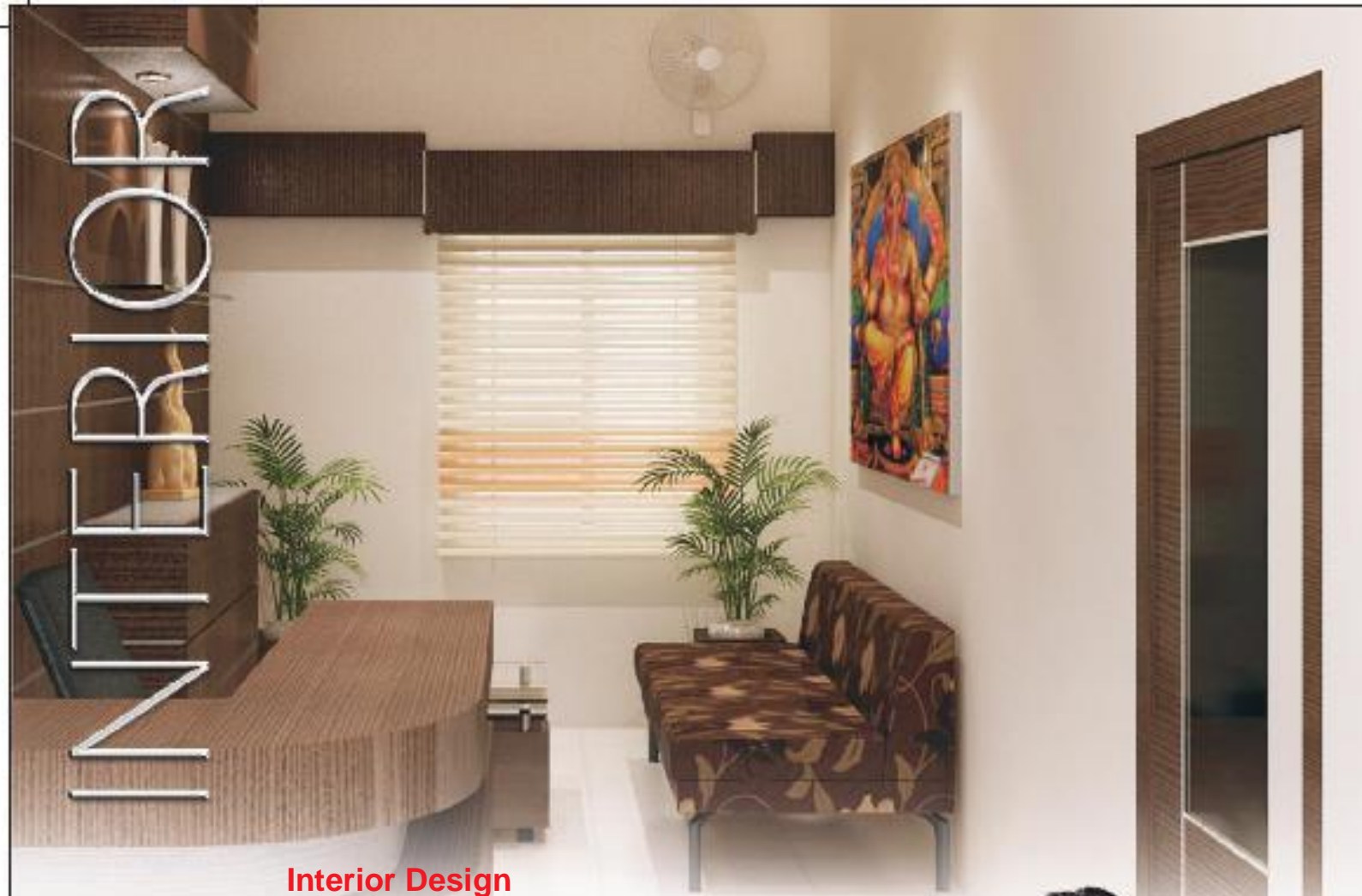

Overview: Interior design is the art or process of designing the interior of any room, space or building. An Interior designer is someone who co-ordinates the layout & design along with colour combination of any particular area either internal or external. Scope of work: As an interior designer, qualified from EXIN, he/she is very well accepted in the market as an interior building designer both for internal and external designing. They are in great demand in hotel industry, resorts, exhibition organiser and event planners. As landscape designer there is a great scope to associate themselves with the hospitality and corporate sector.



of lose / damage of the issued certificate / mark sheet, a duplicate may be acquired, subject to availability of records at the institute. On submission of an application accompanied by a FIR needs to be submitted to the institute with a fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) for each year of certificate / mark sheet that may be required by the candidate. Any application for correction of entry in certificate / mark sheet certificate / mark sheet or issue of fresh certificate / mark sheet should be accompanied by the original certificate / mark sheet along with supporting evidence of the changes required. Corrections will not be made if the entries are found not to match the original information provided by the student in the admission form and its supporting document. The corrected / fresh certificate / mark sheet will be issued, subject to the earlier provision, on payment of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) per annum from the date of the final examination to the date of issue of the rectified certificate / mark sheet.

Seminar / Professional Apprenticeship:

Our co-sponsoring companies in both India and Bangladesh offer presentation to all students on productions and material manufactured by them. Experts from the organisation give lectures and make presentations on fixture fitting and material that are frequently used in the interior design industry primarily related to furnishing, lighting, wood and allied items namely glass, flooring and falls ceiling etc. EXIN is the only organization providing professional apprenticeship facilities to all the students irrespective of their merit of performance. This compulsory internship for 240 hours helps each student to know the profession and receive credits for the program. This hands-on experience bolsters the professionalism within the individual and gears him / her to face the challenges of career in interior architecture.

Attendance & Rules:

Classes are held in 3 shifts starting from 8.00 am till late evening as per preset time table offered by head's of the centers concerned. The routine / timetable may be changed without notice at the discretion of the concerned head's of centers. Minimum of 75% attendance and 100% session sheet submission on time is required to be eligible to appear in any examination. The candidate may be debarred from sitting in the final examination in case of non-compliance of this rule. The right to excuse a student from the class rests at all time with the faculty and the administrative authority. All project submission dates are to be as per deadline set by faculty and administrative authorities and no violation will be allowed. Asia Pacific head office will award zero on this project in case of any violation of this rule. No further reference will be entertained on this issue. It is in the interest of the student to ensure that the sessional sheets, the site visits, guest lectures, seminar reports and the models have been submitted to the EXIN office on time and graded. The program director has the

executive powers to reduce or increase any marks obtained by the student, without any reference to anyone. The decision of the program director is final and is binding on all issues. All lectures and studio classes last for 2 hours and are held 3 days a week. The student is expected to do research, library work and spend time other than in the studio to complete course work. All site visits, workshop visits, guest lectures, seminars and panel discussions are outside class schedules and with no fixed time limit.

Conduct /Discipline/Ragging:

1. In case EXIN takes any policy decision pertaining to first year architecture admission, it shall be done directly by EXIN H.O.
2. Any candidate while studying in any campus is found indulging in any anti-national activities contrary to the rules of the institute and provisions of the act and law enforced by the Government of India will be expelled from the campus without any notice.
Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 in effect from 15th May 1999 is applicable to all candidates found guilty of ragging any other candidate in the institute. All legal action in case of ragging shall be referred to ragging act of 1999.
3. If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "2" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "2" above.
4. If any of the statements made by any candidate and is found to be false as per his / her admission form, his / her admission will be cancelled. Fees will be forfeited and he /she will be expelled from the campus by the competent authority. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however, may be preferred within 7 days to the Director of Technical Council, of EXIN for reconsideration / review. Application form

Unique registration number is offered on uploading of any application form. Before uploading the application form, the candidate need to produce at least one proof of identity, by way of original mark sheet of HSC / identity card of junior college or driving license / passport to name a few. Candidates should take printout of the uploaded application form in duplicate, sign it and hand it over to institute authority whilst the other copy of the application will be retained by the candidate as a proof of submission and candidature.

Rules, regulation and formalities program enrollment:

Tuition Fees:

Tuition fees for each session may be paid in full, in down

payment/installment in each successive month, other than registration amount. Installments are payable within the consecutive months from the date of commencement of the course. Late fee will attract fine @ Rs.150/- per day and or may attract removal of the student from the register / roll after 20 days of non-payment. International students, at any campus have to pay in INR at the time of registration.

Dishonour of Cheque

It has been decided by the management that the institute charge Rs.500.00 (Five hundred only) for every such transaction resulting to the dishonour of cheque from the students / candidates as cheque bouncing charges.

Attendance/Medium of Instruction:
